### Public Announcement

The Executive Council of Public Entity Sint Eustatius,  
hereby announces that in its meeting of December 29, 2022, has approved the

#### **Final Draft Revision of the Spatial Development Plan**

The revision of the Spatial Development Plan aims to adapt the Spatial Development Plan to the spatial consequences of recent and future developments on Sint Eustatius.

The main changes are;

- Renaming of the 7 nature zones. Some of these zones made more possible than just nature. In addition, 2 zones have now been merged.
- General planning permit regulations. These have been included to protect the stability of the cliff and to protect the use of archaeological values, among other things. These regulations apply everywhere, allowing the individual zonings to remain more concise.
- The preconditions for the subdivision plan have been adjusted as result of discussions during the consultations.
- Residential area 1 and 2 have been merged, the residential destination to be worked out has been scrapped because the SDP has now adopted the subdivision plan.

The Final draft revision will be on Public Review and available for inspection for a period of 6 weeks, from February 15<sup>th</sup> through March 29<sup>th</sup> 2023,. During that 6 weeks period, anyone can ask questions about the plan and share ideas and reactions.
